



Surveyed on the fifth Day of July 1793 nine hundred and ninety Acres of Land with the allowance of Six per Cent. situate in district No 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Alleghany River, adjoining Wilhem Willink, and others No 2672; by Virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven and Putger Jan Schimmelpinninck of Amsterdam No 2678; dated the Twelfth Day of December 1792.
