In pursuance of a Warrant granted to David Williamson Dated March the 16th Day 1786 Situate on the Waters of Buffalo<sup>Creek</sup> In Washington County Called Dispute. Containing three Hundred Acres Strict Measure. the Dotted lines is where the above Survey Interferes with a Survey made for Thomas Browlee on a Certificate which is now Patented. I believe It was on the Special Request of Said Williamson that the allowance was not made in the above Draught.
