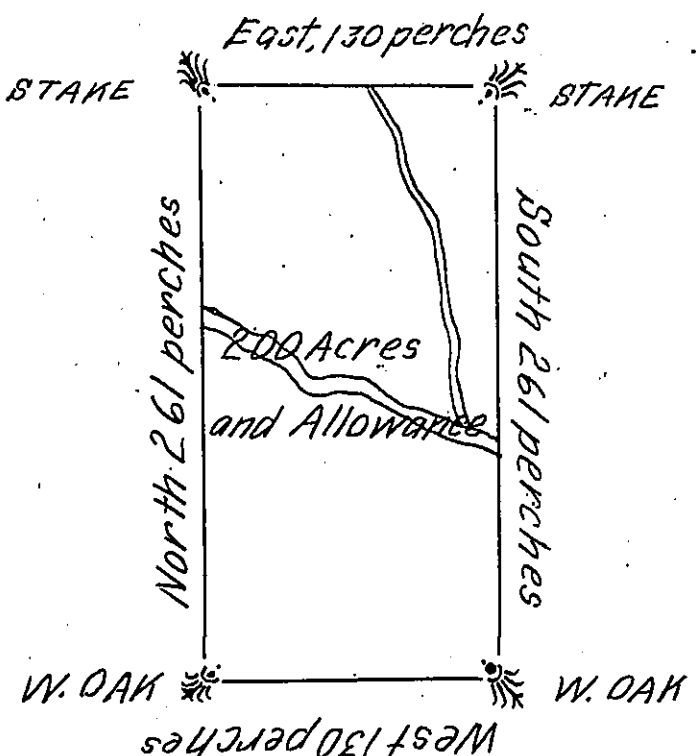


Lot, N^o MCCLXXVII



In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth Day of February 1785, intitled, 'An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth,' and by order of the Surveyor-General, with the approbation of the Honourable the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the fourth Day of December 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land, and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. N^o 1277 situate in District N^o 6 on the West Side of the Allegheny River, in the County of Westmoreland.
