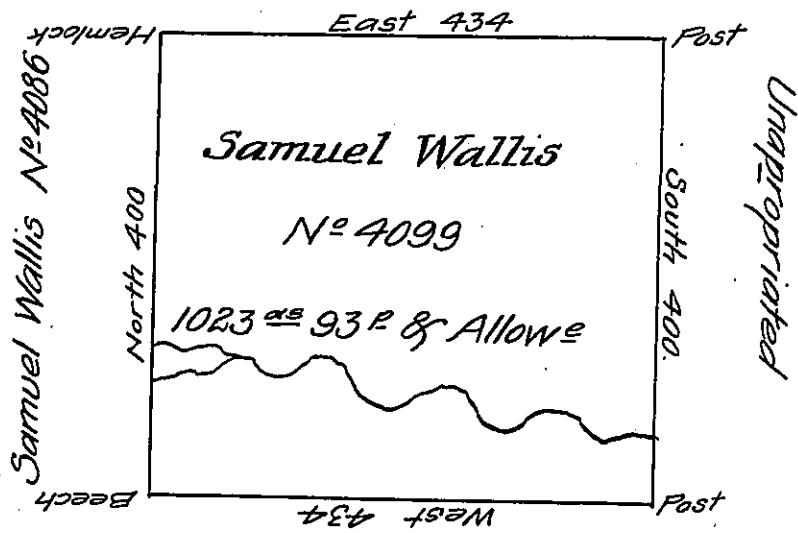

Ct. for Roads &c. Surveyed the Nineteenth day of July 1794 By Warrant to Samuel Wallis N<sup>o</sup> 4099 dated the Second day of October 1793 for 900 A<sup>s</sup>.
