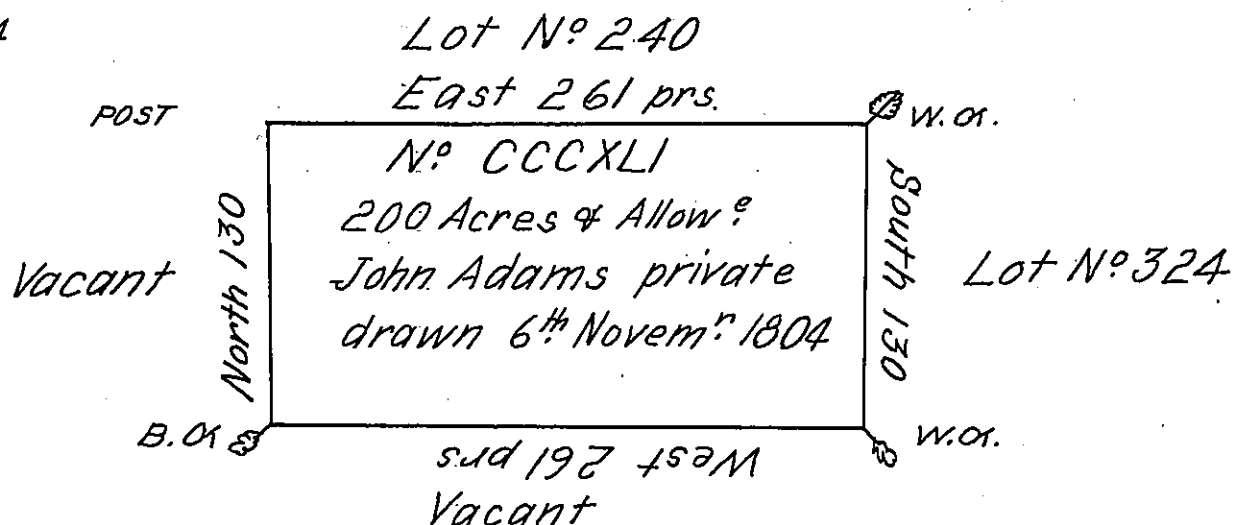

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State
Pennsylva. passed the 24th Day of February 1785 entitled
an Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation
Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth & by
Order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of
the Honourable the Executive Council. I have surveyed
on the 4th Day of November 1785 the above described
Tract of Two Hundred Acres of Land & the Allow^e of Six pr
Cent for Roads N° CCCXLI situate in District N° 2 on the
West Side of Alleghany River in Westmoreland County.
