 ing as above set forth 14^{ac} & 96 perches and allowance being

 originally surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 21st
 of the 11th mo 1769 in pursuance of a warrant for 100^{ac}
 granted to James Savage bearing date the 15th day of
 January 1763. Resurveyed and divided off from the said
 larger tract of land the 6th day of January AD^o 1804
 And now at the request of the present owner George
 Anstine, I am desired to make return of the draught
 as calculated examined and corrected the 14th day
 of February Anno Domini 1810.
