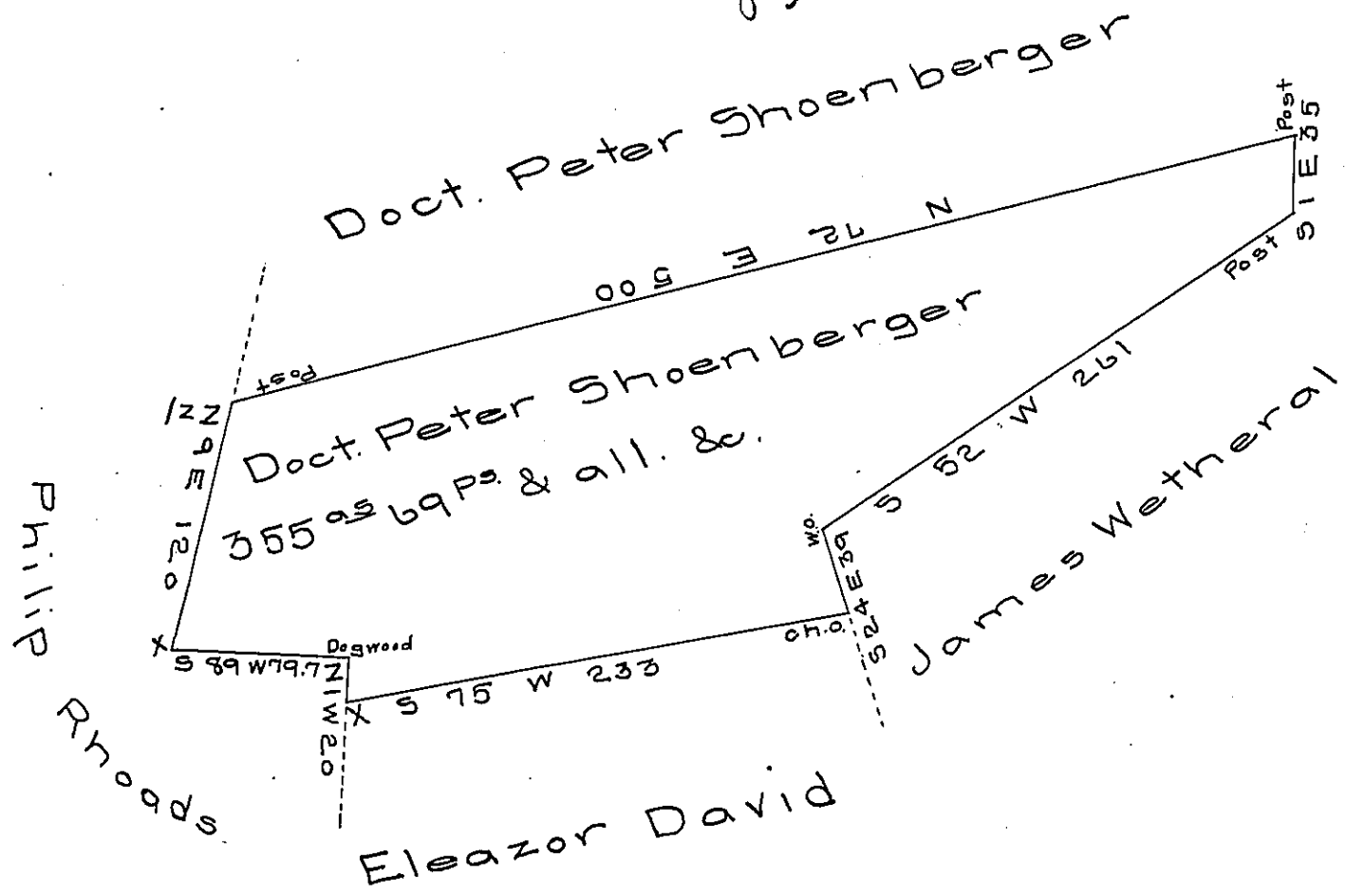

Peter Shoenberger And resurveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August 1841 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 30<sup>th</sup> May 1840 granted to the said Peter Schoenberger for 350 acres &c.

 N.B. There is an old improvement and actual settlement on the above tract of land and about fifty acres cleared Michael Reed D.S.
