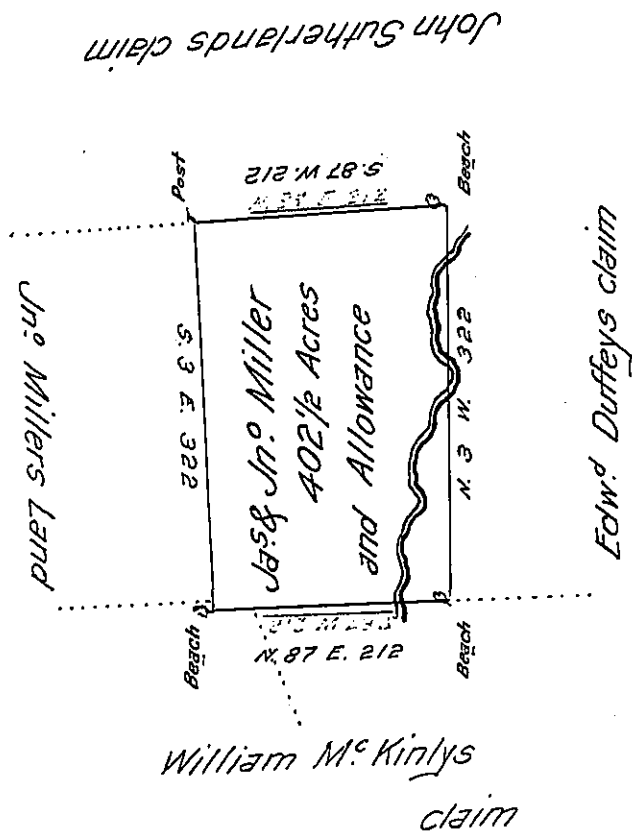

In pursuance of an Improvement said to be made on the 16th day of April 1798 there was Surveyd for James & John Miller the above described Tract of Land containing four hundred and two and a half Acres with an Allowance proportioned to Six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent Situate on the Waters of Wolf Creek North and West of the Rivers of Ohio & Allegheny in District No 5 in the County of Allegheny — Surveyd Oct. 24th. 1799 —
