



Situate in Changeford township in the County of York. Cont. 162 acs. & prs. & allce. Being part of a larger tract of 170 acs. 113 prs. and allce. which was originally surveyed by William Matthews late D. S. on the 9th day of the 4th mo. 1775 in pursuance of two warrants. One for 75 acs. granted to Robert Summers bearing date the 9th of March 1753 and the other for 50 acs. granted to Robert Long bearing date the 27th of March 1775.

Resurveyed and the piece of vacancy where the letter A is placed added at the request of the owner John Stewart 10th of March 1807 who desired me to make return of the draught as calculated, examined and corrected the 26th day of

August A. D. 1809.
