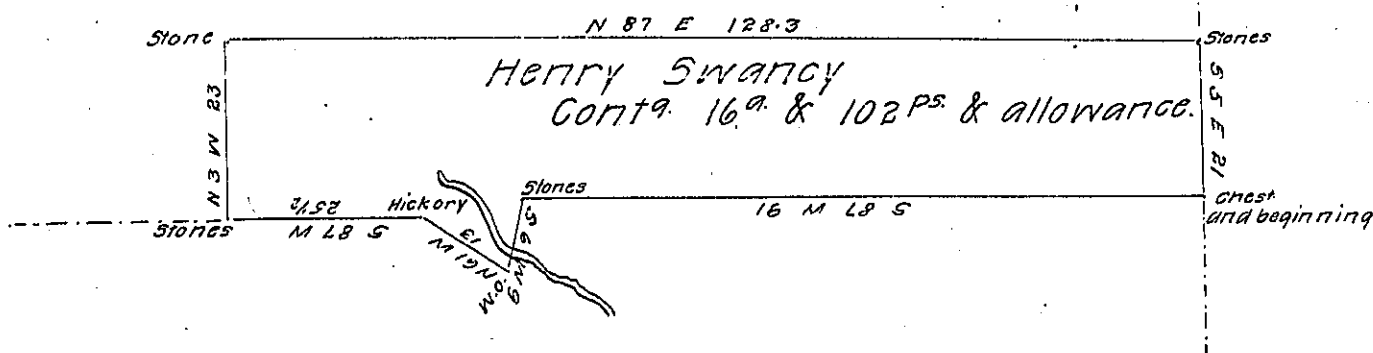

And at the request of Andrew Stine, the Present owner the  
same is now returned for Confirmation, the 20<sup>th</sup> day of Aug-  
ust A.D. 1811.
