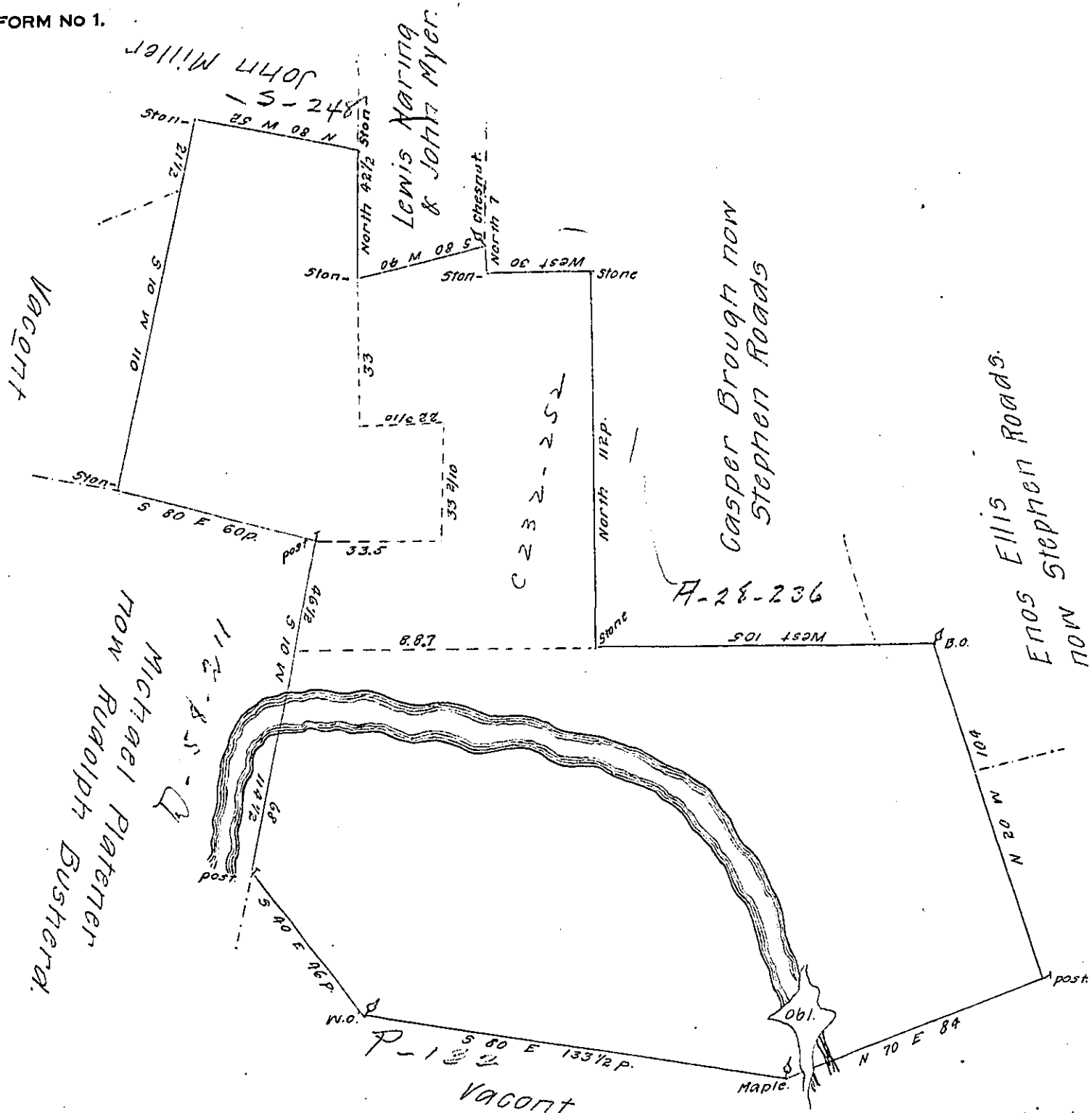

Cent.
