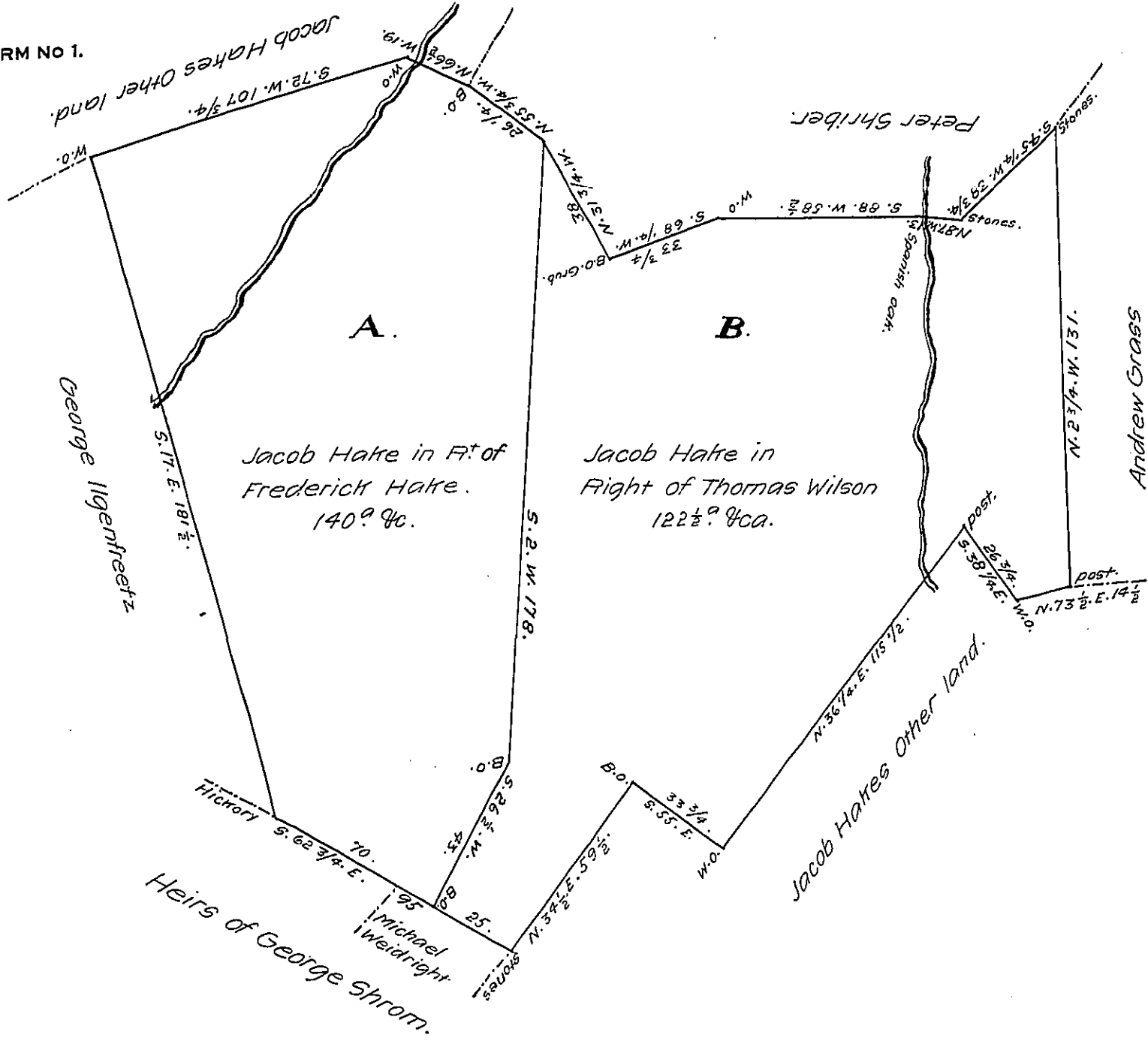


FORM No 1.



A Draught of Two Tracts of land Situate in Manchester Township in the County of York Containing Together Two Hundred and Sixty Two & a half Acres and Allowance Surveyed the 10th April 1788. The Piece Marked with the letter **B** in Pursuance of a Warrant to Thomas Wilson Dated the 6th day of March 1749 Containing one Hundred and Twenty Two and a half Acres & Allowance &c. The Piece Marked with the letter **A** in Pursuance of a Warrant to Frederick Hake Dated the 14th day of March 1767. Containing one Hundred & forty Acres & Allowance .

N.B. The above was one thought to be within the line of the Manor of Springettsbury, but on Examination found to be at least Tw- Miles North of the Manor line.
