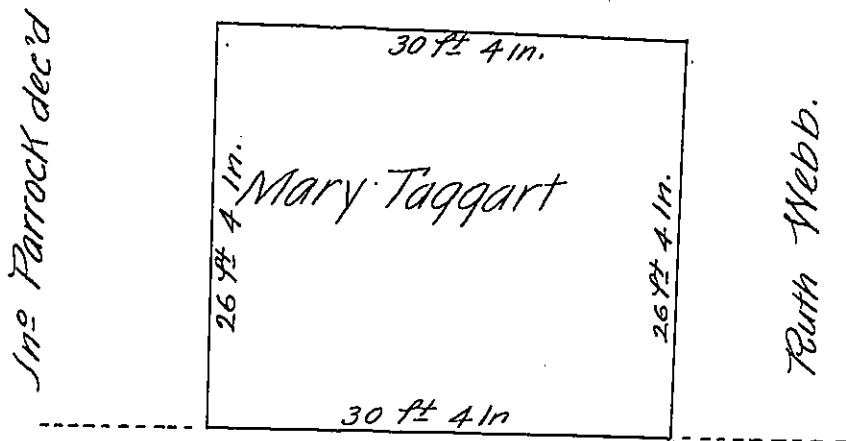


John Doyle
