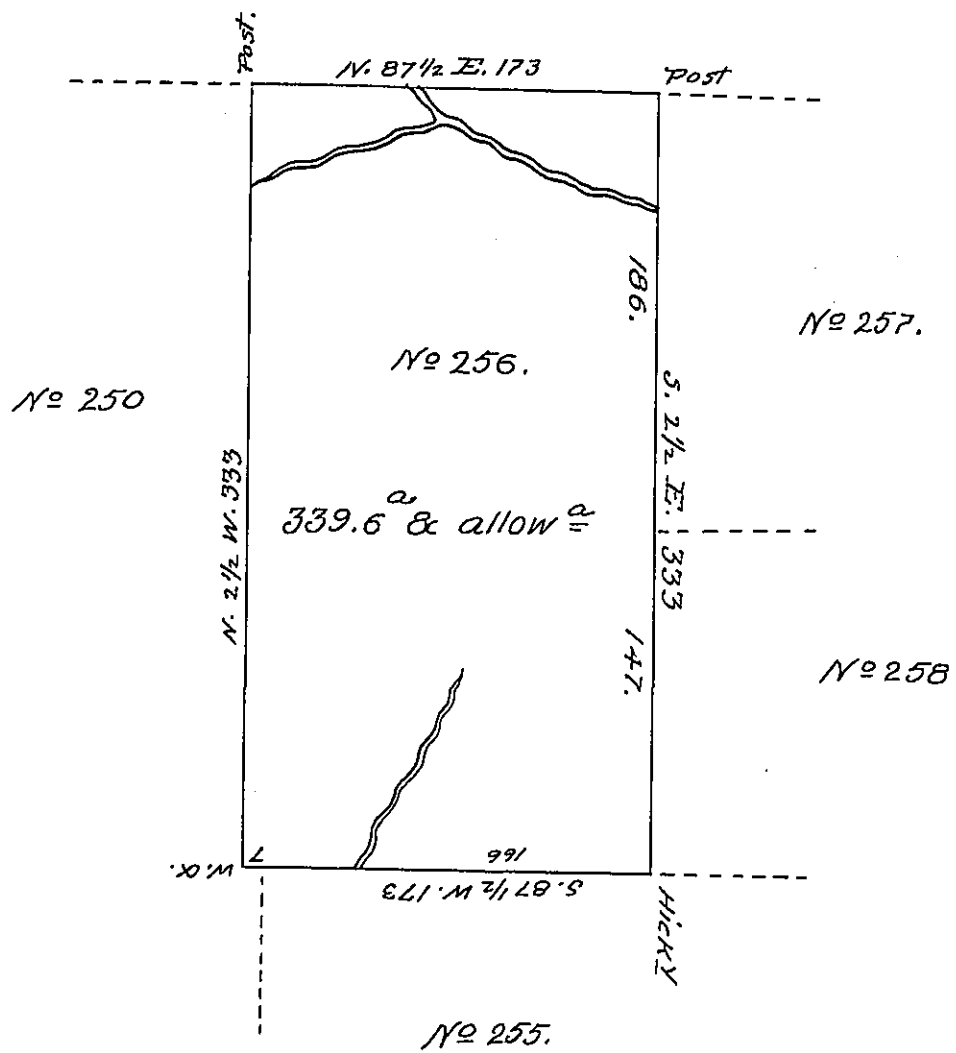


Land not surveyed



Survey'd Oct 11<sup>th</sup> 1785 the above described lot of ground situate on the West side the Allegheni river on the waters of Buffalo creek. Containing three hundred & thirty nine acres & six tenths of an acre & allow<sup>ce</sup> of six  $\phi$ . Cint. By virtue of a Law pass'd the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783. Instituted an act for the sale of certain lands for the purpose of redeeming & paying off the certificates of depreciation given to the officers & soldiers of the Pennayl<sup>a</sup> Line.
