



A Plan of a Lot of Ground Situate on the West side of Beaver Street and North side of Kings Street in the Town of York, marked on the General Plan of the said Town Number one hundred and twelve, containing in Breadth on Beaver Street, aforesaid fifty seven Feet and six Inches, and in Length on Kings Street aforesaid to a Twenty feet Alley, two hundred and Fifty Feet. Bounded Eastward with Beaver Street aforesaid, Southward with Kings Street aforesaid, Westward with a Twenty Feet Alley, and Northward with a Lot of Ground marked on the Plan aforesaid Number one hundred and eleven, formerly surveyed and laid out for Michael Welsh who has built an House thereon according to the Conditions of Settling the said Town.
