



A Draught of a tract of land situate in Rockland Township (and but a small part thereof in Richmond Township) in the county of Berks and Province of Pennsylvania Containing one hundred and sixteen acres and 140 Perches of Land together with the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads That was surveyed unto Jacob Tryblepiss, in pursuance of Two Warrants granted to him by the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries, The first is dated on the 1<sup>st</sup> March Anno-1750 and the Second on the 11<sup>th</sup> April Anno-1752 each Warrant for fifty acres. now resurveyed by order of the Surveyor General on the 24<sup>th</sup> March Anno-1774
