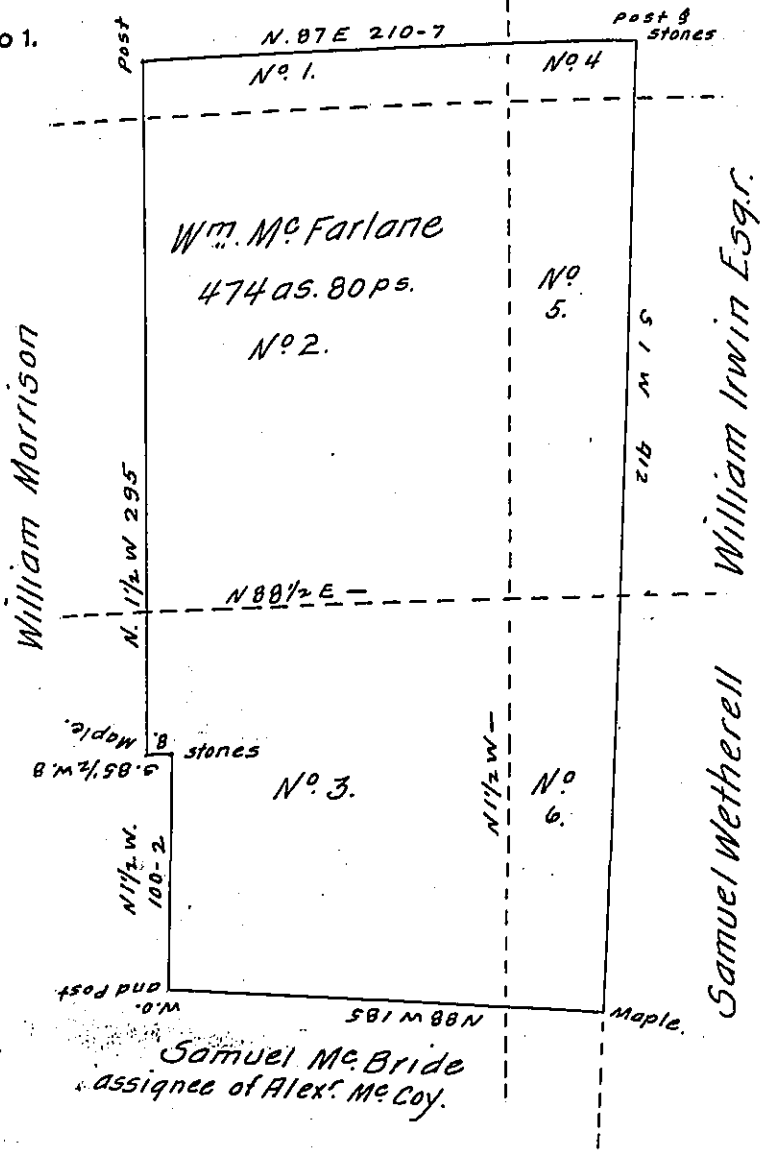

The above is a draft of a Survey made the 6th day of April A.D. 1829 in pursuance of Six Warrants granted to John Wilson, William Will, John Wilcocks, Robert Irwin, William Irwin Esqr and Samuel Wetherell, dated the 14th day of April 1792, and embracing a part of each Warrant, and also in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property, to Re-survey According to Kerrs lines, dated the 11th day of March A.D. 1829. Situate on the waters of Mahoning Creek, in Mahoning Township, Mercer County and State of Pennsylvania, Containing four hundred and Seventy four acres, and eighty perches, and the usual allowance of Six per cent. for Roads. The dotted lines represent the Warrant lines. and Shows the interference. The parts are numbered, and refer to the Margin. to Show the Warrantees names, and quantity. taken of each Warrant
