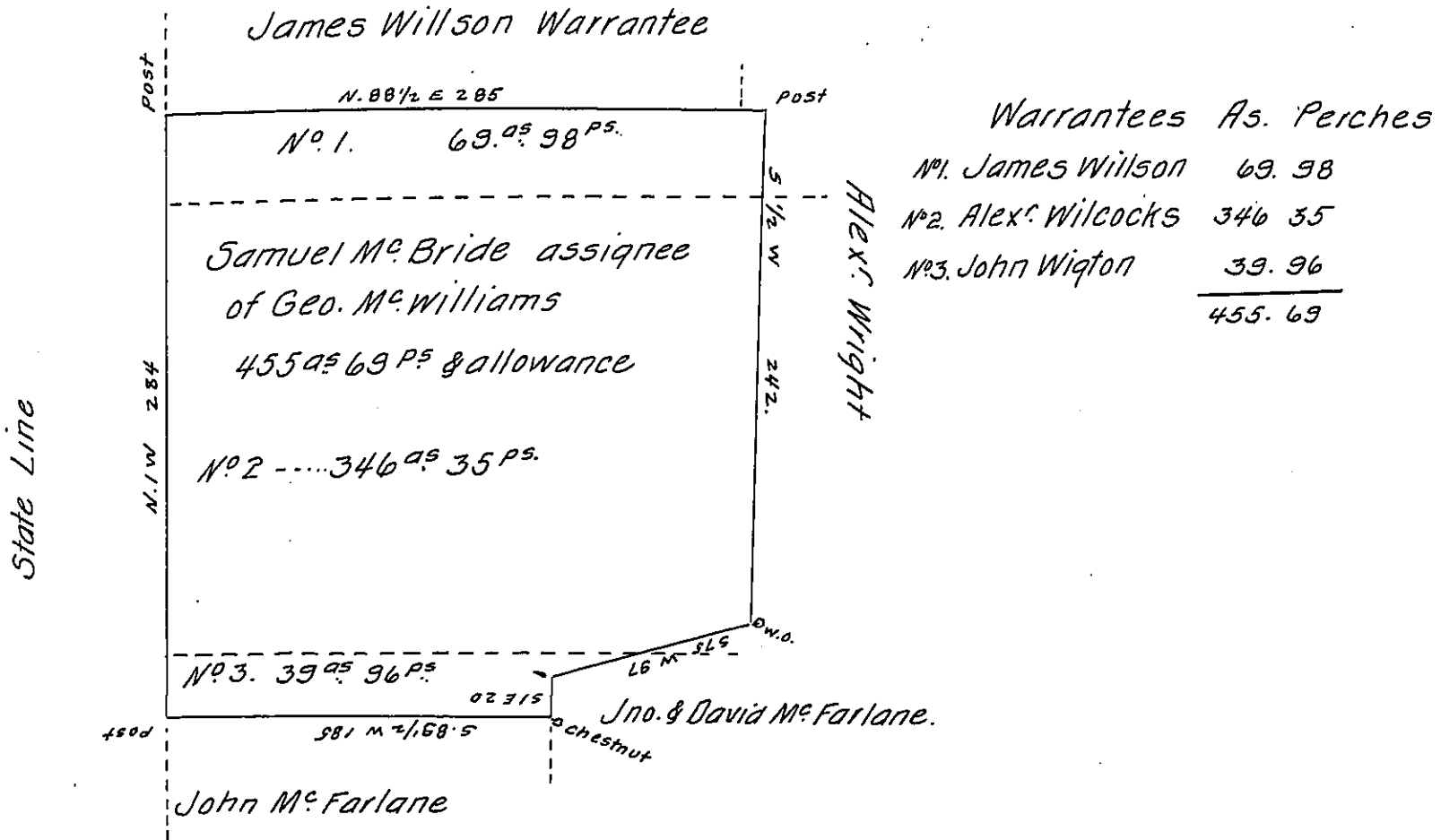


FORM NO 1.



*The above is a draught of a Survey made the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March 1829. in pursuance of three Warrants, granted to James Willson, Alexr. Wilcocks and John Wigton, dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792. and containing a part of each, And also in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property to Resurvey according to Kerrs lines dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1829. Situate on the Waters of Mahoning Creek. in Mahoning Township, Mercer County and State of Pennsylvania. Containing four hundred and fifty five acres and sixty nine perches and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads. The dotted lines represent the Warrant lines. The parts are numbered and referes to the margin to show the Warrantees names and the Quantity embraced of each Warrant.*
