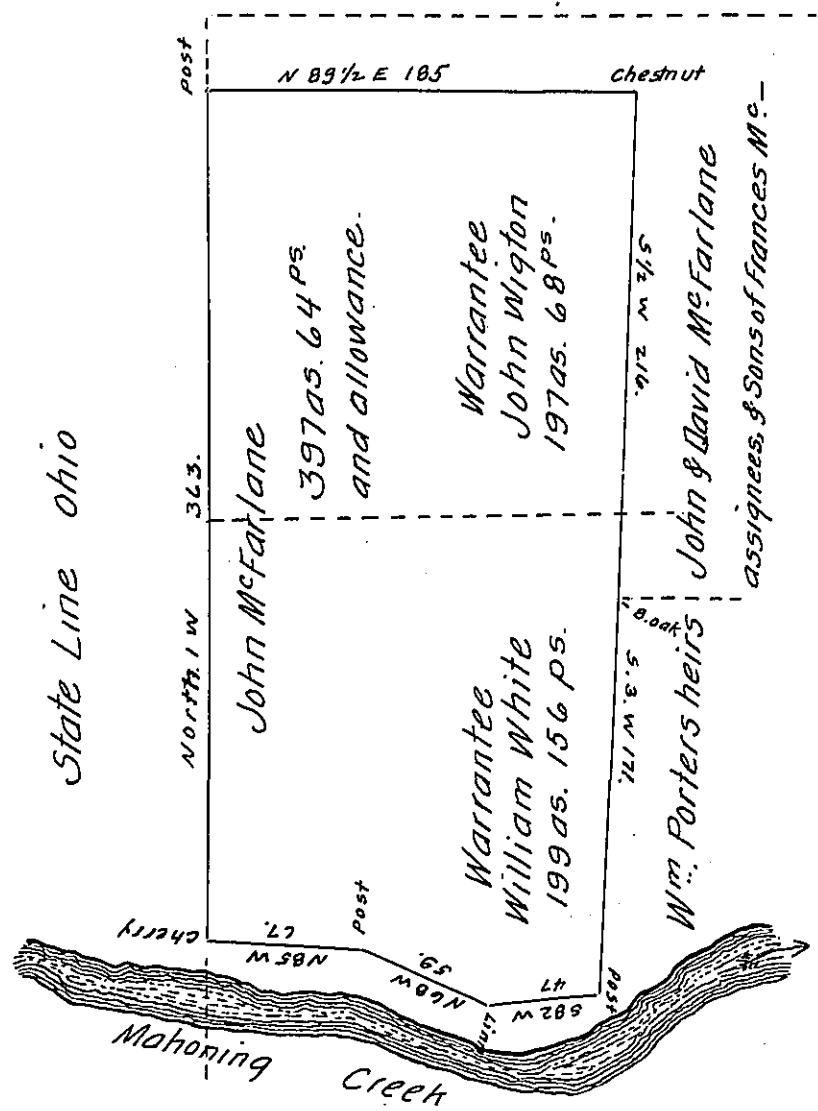


Samuel Mc Bride



The above is a draught of a Survey made 3^d day of April A. D. 1829. in pursuance of Two Warrant's granted to William White, and John Wigton, on the 14th day of April 1792, and embracing a part of each. And also in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property, to resurvey, according to Kerr's lines, dated the 11th day of March 1829. Situate on Mahoning Creek, in Mahoning Township, Mercer County State of Pennsylvania. Containing three hundred and ninety Seven acres, and Sixty four perches, and allowance of Six per Cent. for Roads. The dotted line, represents the Warrant line. and the Warrantees names and Quantity of each are entered in the plat.
