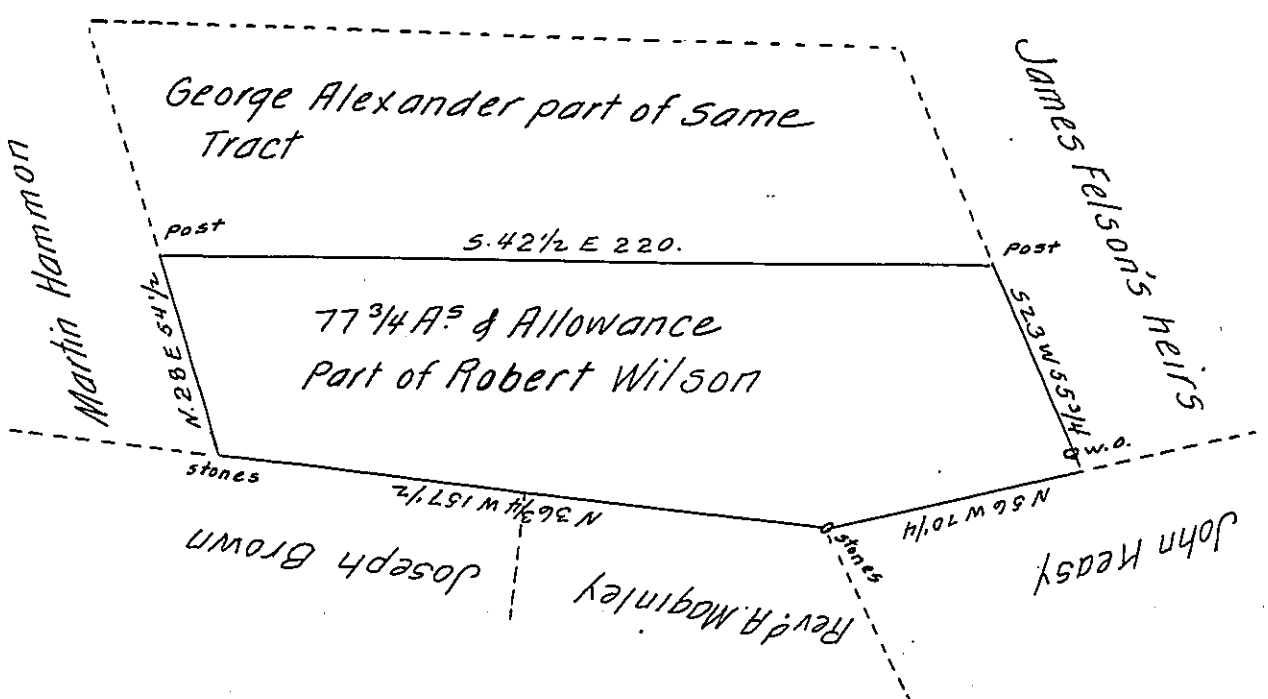


FORM NO 1.  
This is to certify. That the enclosed Returns .to wit. 77<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub><sup>ac</sup> in part of a Warrant Granted Robert Wilson dated 4 June 1762 - And 48<sup>ac</sup> 103<sup>ac</sup> in part of a Warrant to Alexander Potts & Brothers dated 17 Sept: 1784. Are the same pieces of Land as Returned 18<sup>th</sup> of Last May. - But ascertaining since said Returns that my Chain when making the former Surveys was one Link two short. by having a Link Lost out. - whereby the quantity of Land was made to be more than ~~than~~ the real quantity - Therefore I have since corrected the said Surveys & made out new Returns; which I pray may be accepted. and the former Returns given up to be canceled.

Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Metal Township Franklin County. containing seventy seven Acres and three quarters & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. being part of a larger Tract of 153<sup>ac</sup> 39<sup>ac</sup>. Surveyed 21 May 1811. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Robert Wilson bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June 1762. Resurveyed & divided off the above part for Jacob Sharer the 29<sup>th</sup> of October 1829. under the direction of W<sup>m</sup> Hamilton Esq: late Deputy Surveyor. of Franklin County. Certified the 25<sup>th</sup> January 1831.
