Being part of a larger tract 262^{as 8 prs} & allowance. Originally Surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 11th day of June 1757 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to George Whitman dated the 9th day of August 1751 - the Said part Resurveyed and divided off from the Said larger tract on the 20th day of June 1798. and now at the request of John Hildebrand (Joined the same is examined and corrected. and Returned for confirmation April 16th 1822.
