



The above is a Draught of a Survey made December 31st 1828 in pursu-
 ance of a Warrant, granted to Jacob Williams, for one Acre of land. Dated
 November 26th 1828. but Contains one Acre & 56 perches and Allowance
 of six pr. Cent for highways. Situate in West Bethlehem Township, W.C.
 on the waters of Ten mile Creek. At the time of Survey, there was an actual
 settlement on the premises, by the Owner which appears to have been
 kept up for several years.
