



The above is a draught of a Tract of land situate on the waters of Cross-creek in Hopewell township in Washington county; containing one hundred and fifty acres, and one hundred and thirty one perches and the usual allowance. Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Wiley for one hundred and fifty acres, dated October 16<sup>th</sup> 1787, and executed April 3<sup>d</sup> 1816.

This tract was first improved in the spring of 1775, and a constant resident settlement kept up ever since - the land is now largely improved and a family residing thereon - There is no opposing claim whatever.
