



Survey'd the above described Island on the 24th day of September 1814 in Obediance to an order of the Board of Property for valuation dated the 28th day of July 1814. Containing as above represented one half acre strict measure. Situate near the middle of the West Branch of Susquehanna about two miles below the point of the Great Island the farm of John Ziegler in Dunstable Township on the North side, and — Yider in Wayne Township on the South side (known by the name of Kerrs Island) in Lycoming County. And in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John White on the 20th of February 1815 return the same at his request on the 28th day of ~~March~~ the month & year last mentioned
