



Situate on the Waters of Coxes Creek in Milford Township

 Dated the 30th day of May 1801. the latter by Warrant Dated the 26th of
 August 1801. both descriptive of and intended for the above described Tract
 of land, said Winger Claims by virtue of an Improvement and purchase
 made previous to said Kitzmiller settling and Claiming the same, and said
 Winger further asserts he can prove that said Kitzmiller covenanted to pay
 the Tax on said Land Annually in lieu of Rent to him.

I have furnished each party with duplicate Draughts of
 said land without inserting either of their names, that the Honorable
 Board of Property may insert the name of the party that have the best
 right to the same after hearing a fair Investigation of the facts that
 may be laid before them by the parties &c.
