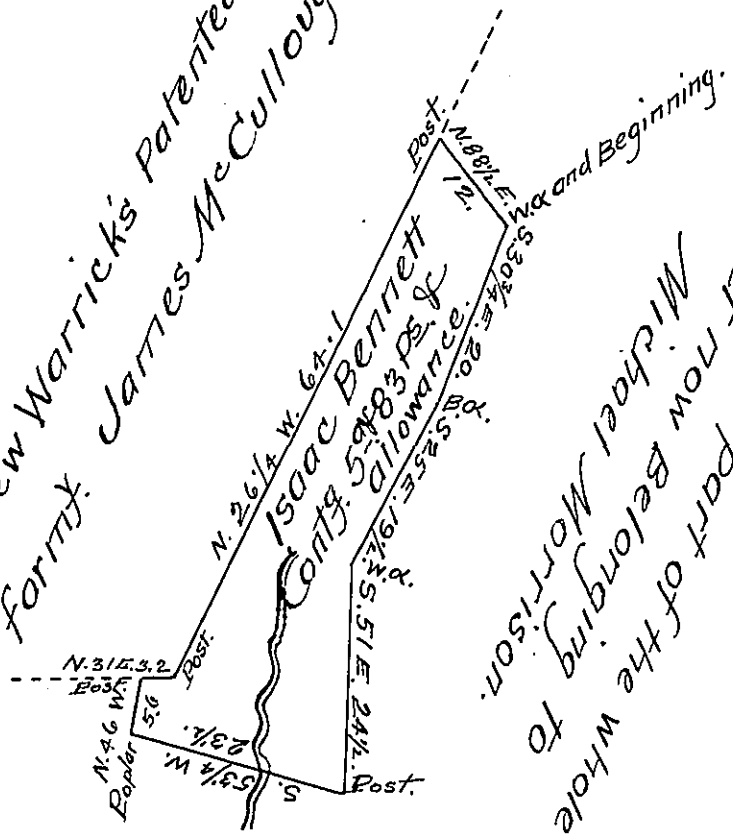


Andrew Warrick's Patented Land

ance. Being part of a larger Tract of Land which was
originally Surveyed on the 14th of the 7th Month 1772
In pursuance of the Application No. 5397 for 300^{ac}
Granted to Isaac Bennett dated the 27th of March
1769. Resurveyed and divided off from the said
larger Tract of Land the 30th day of June Anno Dom-
ini 1809 for Andrew Warrick the present owner—
who desired me to make Return of the Draught.
