



Situate in Westpenn Township Schuylkill County and containing in part marked letter A. <sup>A.</sup> 47-<sup>Per</sup> 110 Strict measure, it being part of the same tract of land of <sup>A.</sup> 80 1/2 acres which was originally surveyed to Nicholas Wehr, by virtue of a warrant granted to him for 178 acres and allowance and dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1786 afterwards conveyed to Levi Hies-ter and others, from which, Solomon and Adam Gultner purchased the same and now conveyed unto Peter Seiberling and surveyed this 29<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1850
