 98 perches and the usual allowance &c. Surveyed on the  
 10 day of August 1831 in pursuance of a warrant granted  
 to Roger Williams for 25<sup>ac</sup>. dated the 4<sup>th</sup> of August 1750 and  
 by virtue of the Contract entered into with the Board of Property.

Report- This Land is now owned and occupied by  
 Daniel Kline whose title papers recite that it was  
 originally Surveyed in pursuance of two warrants dated  
 4<sup>th</sup> day of ——— 1753. The dotted Lines represent  
 the Ballance of the original Survey.
