



The above Draught Represents the Land Thomas Steel Claims by virtue of his appⁿ. N^o 3725 for 40^a dated the 23^d of May 1767 and the Judgement of the Board dated the 27th of August 1770, and at his Request I have laid Down the Draught of it for the Board to Judge on in the dispute Between him and Robert Donald and William Rowan and I do Hereby Certifie that when I surveyed Andrew Rowans place in the year 1768 he Requested Steel to take the Land left out by him the said Rowan, the B. & Marked A is the Box that I marked in the General plan as supposed to be Daniel McConnells original ^{with the letter D} Corner as also the W. & marked B is therein marked with the letter A. Laid Down from the original Draughts.
