



Situate in Tybaine Township Perry County Containing Fifty Five acres twenty four perches & allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. Originally Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> day September 1797. In pursuance of a warrant Granted Joseph Wallace for 50<sup>ac</sup> dated 27<sup>th</sup> January 1797. Resurveyed May 11<sup>th</sup> 1829 And a Small part excluded at the North West Corner which Interfered with a Survey of John Blair now the property of John Nelson's Heirs. Resurveyed as above for Philip Stumbaugh the Owner to Deed Gabriel Hiester Esq. P. W. Wilson D.S. Surveyor General of Pa.
