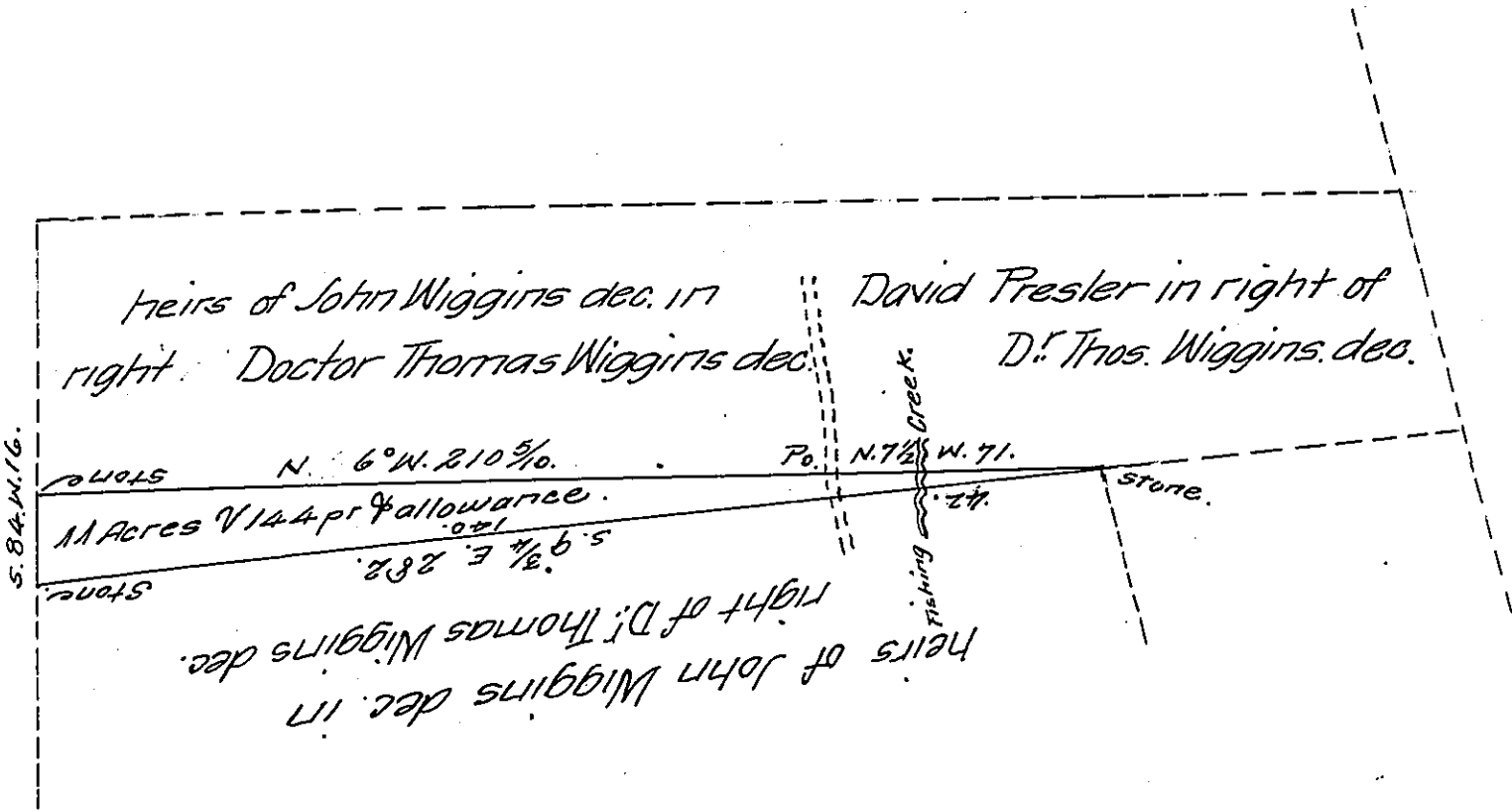


Dr. William Simontons land.
