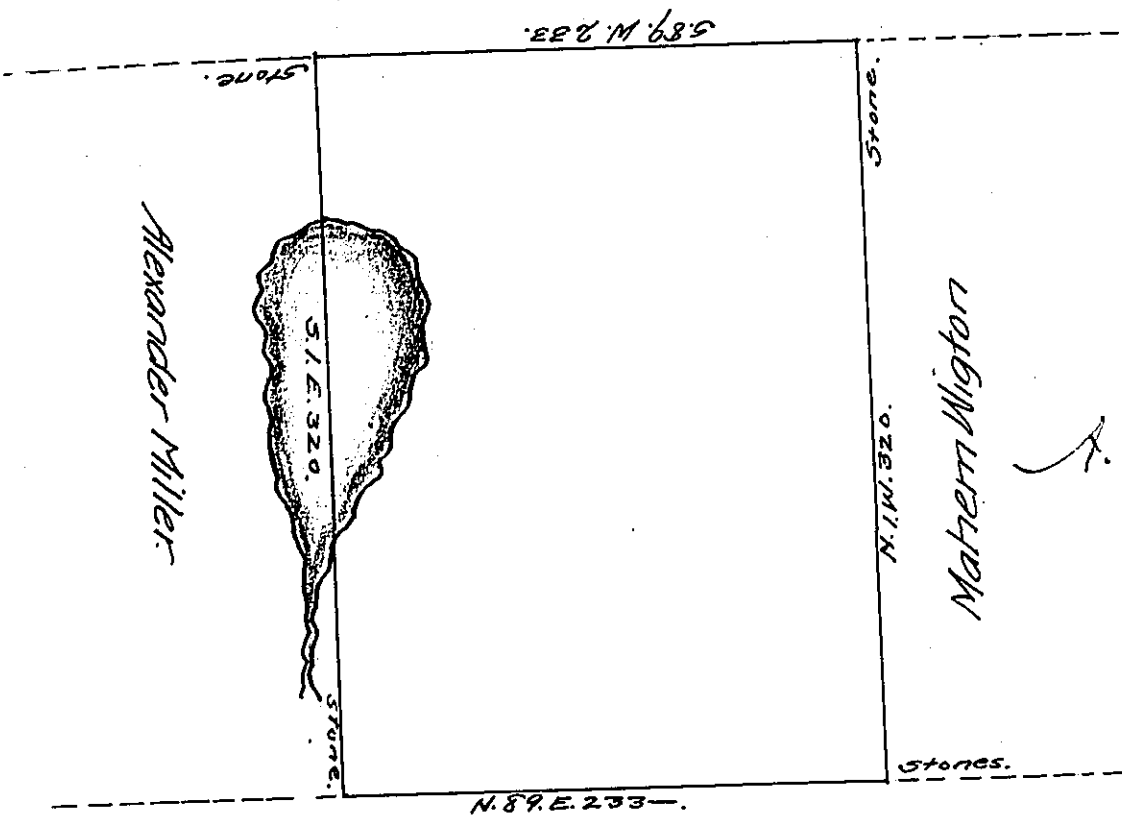

Surveyed the 4th November 1794. to William Wigton the above described tract of land Situate on little Peachpond about one mile and an half from Blooming grove house in the County of Northampton. Containing four hundred and thirty nine Acres ninety nine perches and the allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent $\frac{1}{2}$.
