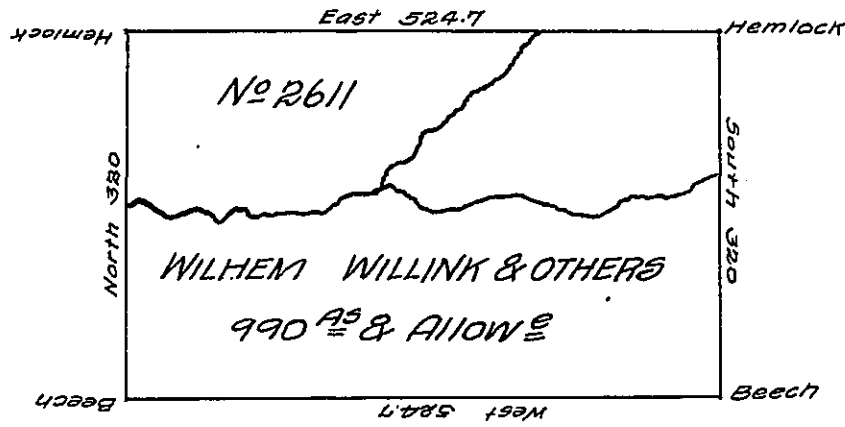

Situate in the last Purchase District No 4 on the Waters of big Toby's Creek about a Mile & 3/4 West of the twenty eight Mile of the line of Dist No 3 Surveyed the Ninth day of July 1793 In pursuance of a Warrant No 2611 to Wilhem Willink, Nicholaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrik Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam, Dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 900 A^s Containing Nine hundred & Ninety A^s & the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c. For Daniel Brodhead Esq^r S. G.
