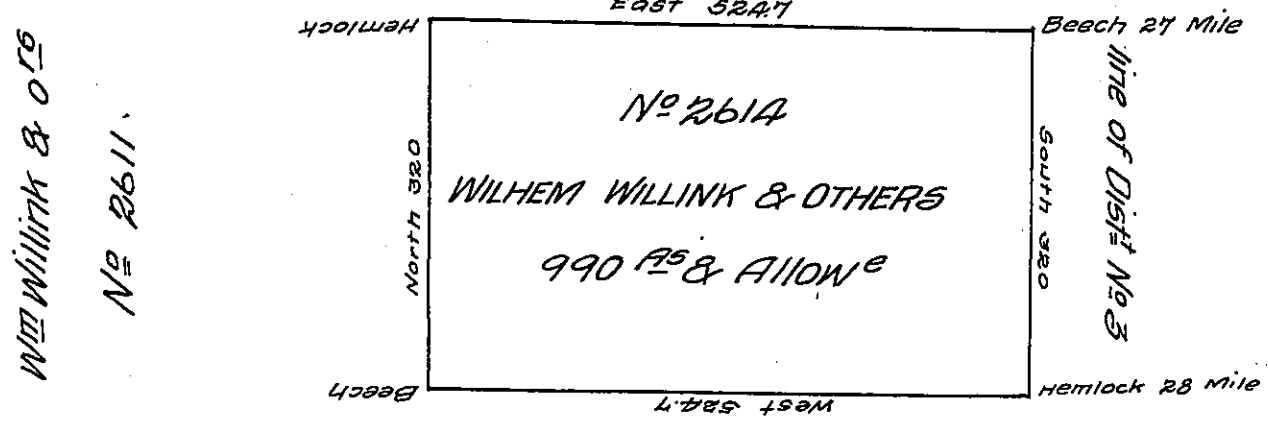

Dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 900 As Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety Acres and the Usual Allowance of Six Pr. Ct. for Roads
