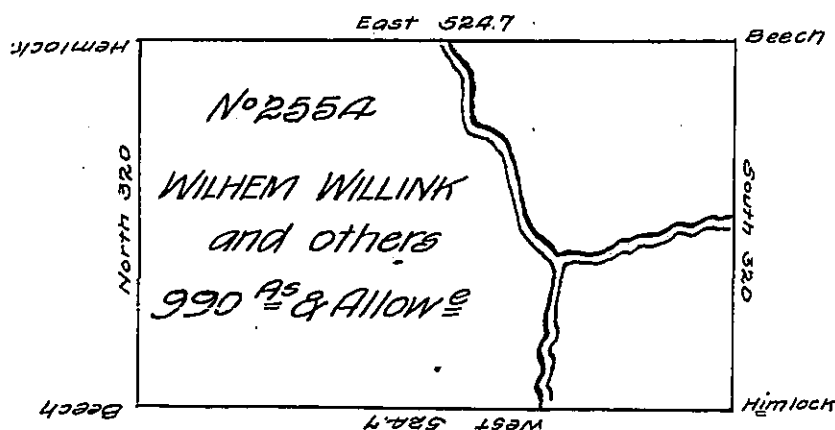

In pursuance of a Warrant No 2791 2554. to Wilhem Willink, Nicholaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrik Vollenhoven, and Putger Jan Schimmelpenninck, of Amsterdam, Dated the 12th day of December 1792 for Nine Hundred A^s Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety A^s & the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c. For Daniel Brodhead Esq^r S. G.
