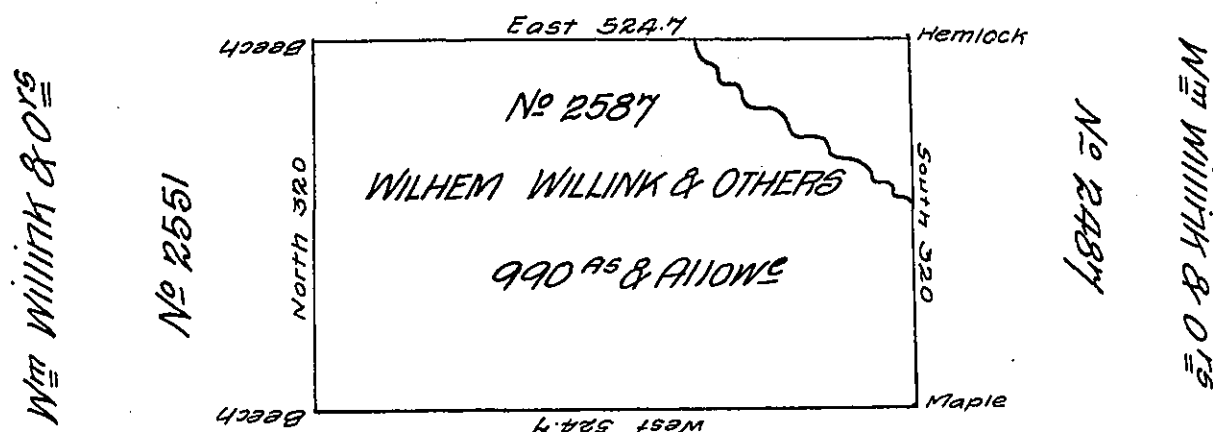

VACANT

Situate a Mile & $\frac{3}{4}$ West of the thirty one Mile Tree of the line of Dist. N^o 3. on the waters of big Toby's Creek in the last purchase Dist N^o 4. Surveyed the Ninth day of July 1793. In pursuance of a Warrant N^o 2587 to Wilhelm Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven & Flutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam. Dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 900 AS containing Nine Hundred and Ninety AS & the Usual Allow^e of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c.
