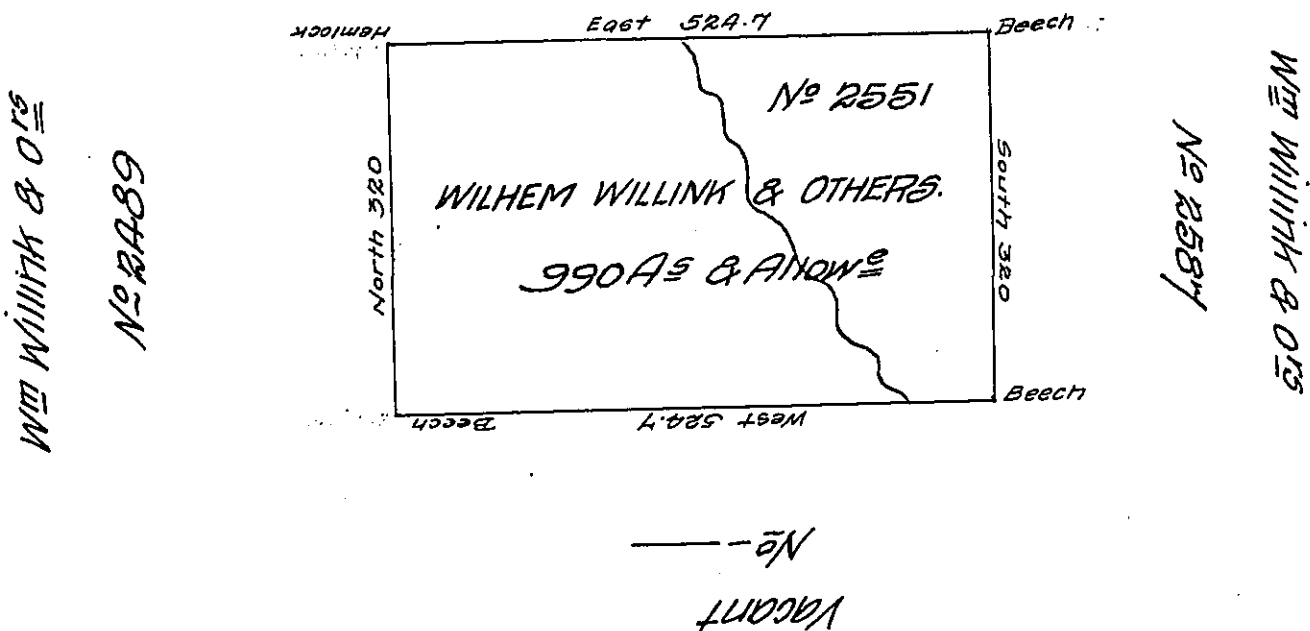


Wilhem. Willink & O<sup>rs</sup>

No 4 Surveyed the tenth day of July 1793 In pursuance of a Warrant No 2551 to Wilhem Willink, Nicholaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrik Vollenhoven, & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam Dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 900 As containing Nine Hundred & Ninety Acres & the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c.
