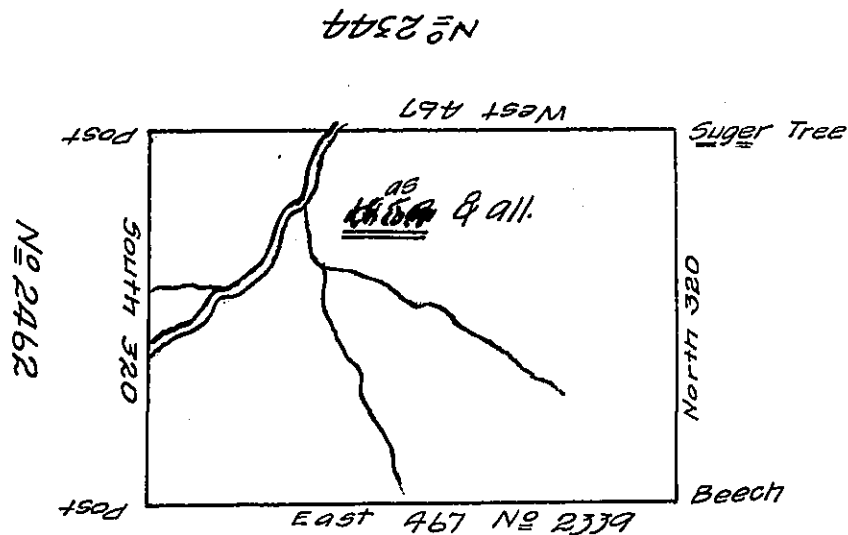

Situate about one Mile and a half west of the Portage Branch of Alleghane and five Miles South of the Canoe place on the Alleghaney River in North<sup>e</sup> County, containing 881 Acres and the Usual allowance for Roads &c. Surveyed July 12<sup>th</sup> 1793 for Wilhem Willirik, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christian Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger San Schimmelpenninck in persewance of a Warrant N<sup>o</sup> 2327 bearing date December 12<sup>th</sup> 1792
