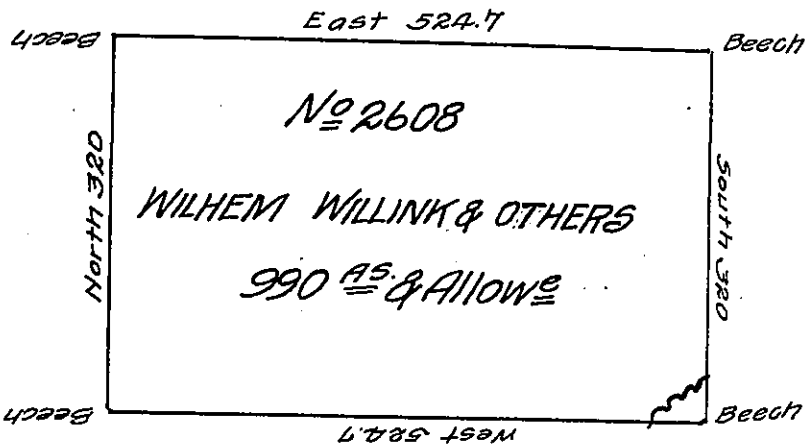

Situate in the last purchase District No 4 on the Waters of big Toby's Creek about a Mile & three fourths West of the twenty Mile of the line of Dist^t No 3 Surveyed the Ninth day of July 1793. In pursuance of a Warrant No 2608 to Wilhem Willink, Nicholaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam, Dated the twelfth day of December, 1792 for 900 A^s Containing Nine hundred & Ninety A^s & the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c.
