



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 17th day 1794. in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to William Wilson for 400 acres of Land Dated the tenth day of February 1794. adjoining Adamson Tannehill to the Eastward and South Side of the Conaquesing Creek including a part of said Creek North and West of the River Ohio. Called Millbuck Containing four Hundred thirty six acres three Quarters and twenty five poles together with the usual allowance of Six P^{ct} Cent for Roads.
