

Resurveyed by the old lines on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of September 1806 And now, at the

request of Samuel Ilgenfritz & George Krone, Executors of the last Will & Testament

of John Philip Krone dec'd it is returned for Confirmation for the use and benefit of

the heirs of the said John Philip Krone dec'd the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August, Anno Domini 1809
