



Situate in Shrewsbury Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 48^a & 53 Perches and allowance &c Being part of a larger Tract of Land of 123^a & allowance &c which originally Surveyed by William Mathews late D.S. on the 16th of the 1st Month A.D. 1767 for Nicholas Henry. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 100^a Granted to Nicholas Warick (alias Weirick) bearing date the 25th day of January A.D. 1754. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 9th day of June A.D. 1808. And now at the request of the Present owner Henry Yeider Calculated, examined &c the 27th day of July A.D. 1810. who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation.
