

Situate in Shrewsbury Township in the County, Containing as above set forth thirty one Acres and thirty four perches and the usual allowance &c Being part of a larger Tract of 123⁹ and allowance &c which was Originally Surveyed by William Mathews late D.S. on the 16th of the 1st Month 1767 for Nicholas Henry In Pursuance of a Warrant for 100⁹ Granted to Nicholas Warick bearing date the 25th day of January A.D. 1754. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land by William Hersey late D.S. on the 27th of the 3^d Month 1794. And now at the request of the present owner George Henry, the same has been Calculated examined, Protracted &c and at his request returned for Confirmation the 29th day of November A.D. 1810. Per
