



Situate in the township of Menallen and County of Fayette Surveyed on the 9th day of May 1840 for 3 acres & 77 perches & the allowance of 6 per Cent. In pursuance of a warrant granted to John Wood for 3 acres & 80 perches dated the 28th day of April A. D. 1840. About two thirds of this land is Cleared of timber, but no buildings on it, May have been Settled 20 or 30 years.
