



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Deerfield situate on the heads of a Run which empties into the west side of the Chest Creek adjoining Land Surveyed for Jesse Williamson Jeremiah Williamson and John Hudson about two Miles a little to the north of east from Hart's Sleeping Place in the County of Bedford Containing three hundred and forty five Acres and the usual Allowance of six P Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the first Day of October 1778 for David Williamson in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him Dated the fifth Day of August in the year aforesaid by
