

A Draught of a Tract of Land called Deerfield Situate on the Waters of the Chest Creek about three Miles Northeast from Hart's Sleeping place adjoining Lands Surveyed for Jeremiah Williamson & David Williamson in the County of Bedford Containing three hundred and four Acres & one quarter of an Acre and the usual Allowance of six P.Cent. for Roads &c. Surveyed the first Day of October 1773 for Jesse Williamson in pursuance of a Warrant Dated the fifth Day of August in the same year by Thomas Smith D.S. To John Lukens Esq. Surveyor General\_of Pennsylvania &c
