

Situate in Fawn now Peach Bottom Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 116 2/3 perches and allowance being part of a larger tract of 176 2/3 perches and the allowance which was originally Surveyed to the heirs of Robert Taylor in pursuance of a warrant granted to Hugh Whiteford and John Taylor executors of the said Robert Taylor the warrant bearing date September 24th 1765 and now on the 18th Day of August A.D. 1838 the same is resurveyed, calculated, corrected and is now returned for Confirmation at the request of James Ramsay the present owner who wishes to patent it.
