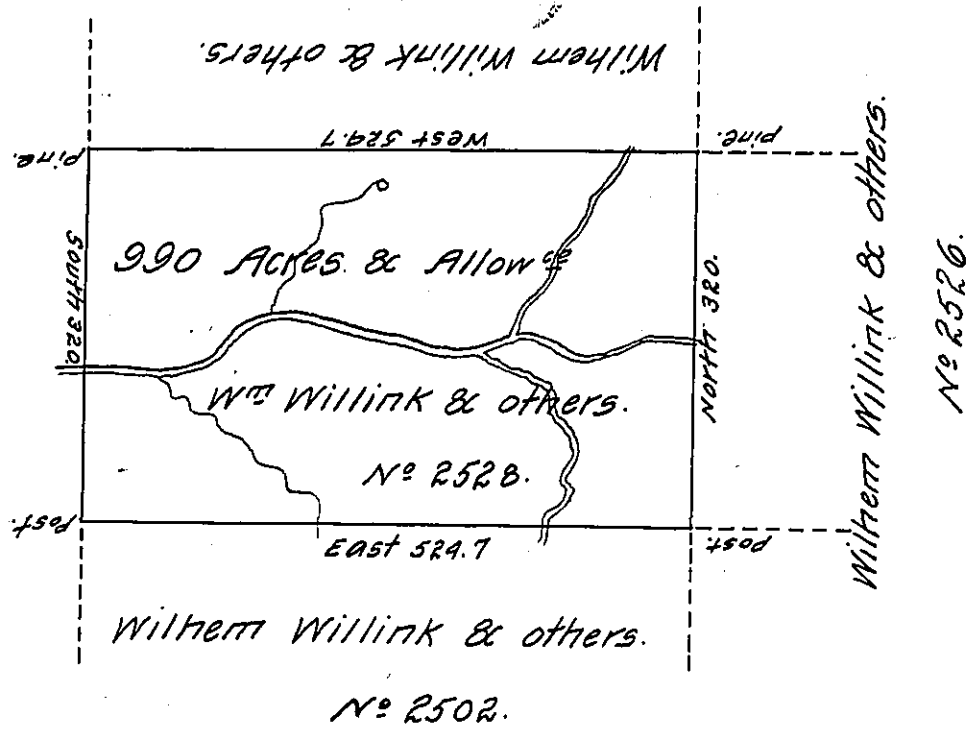

Surveyed on the third Day of July 1793 nine hundred and ninety Acres of Land with the allowance of Six per Cent Situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River; adjoining Wilhem Willink and others N<sup>o</sup> 2526; by Virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinninck of Amsterdam N<sup>o</sup> 2528; dated the Twelfth Day of December 1792.
