



Surveyed on the twenty ninth Day of June 1793 nine hundred and ninety Acres of Land with the Allowance of six per Cent. situate in District N° 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River; adjoining Wilhem Willink and others N° 2740; by Virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eghei, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinnick of Amsterdam N° 2741; dated the 13th Day of December 1792.
