



Surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1793 nine hundred and ninety Acres of Land with the allowance of Six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent, situate in District No. 6 in the late Purchase on the East Side of the Alleghany River; on the North Side of Toby's Creek on the Path to Cutchushing; by Virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinninck of Amsterdam No 2922 dated the thirteenth Day of December 1792.
